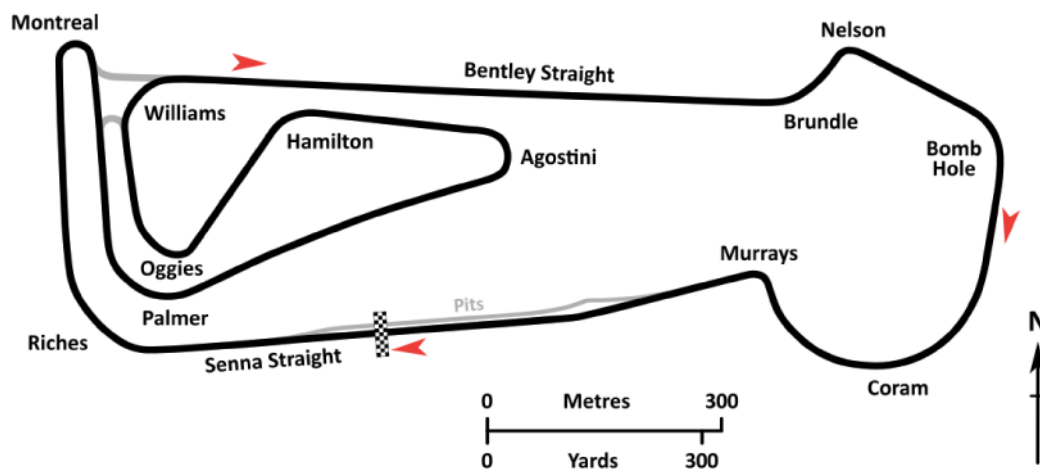




Snetterton Race Circuit
